<p>Primary care network (group of GP practices working together)</p>	<p>We belong to the Mid Kent Primary care network (“MK PCN”) which is a group of GP practices in the Mid Kent area (a patient centered organisation), working collaboratively and developing closer integration with other partners across health, social and third sector partners to facilitate an enhanced delivery of health and care services across the Mid Kent areas.</p> <p>Operating as a centralised hub in the community, the Mid Kent PCN provide direct health and care services such as extended hours access to the GP service, minor illness service, home visits, women clinic, first contact physiotherapy, mental health practitioner and other services that may be added from time to time across Mid Kent and environs.</p> <p>If you visit or receive treatment/consultation on any of these services, personal data concerning your GP medical record may be shared with the PCN and their Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) in order to enable them make the best informed decision about your health/care needs, and provide you with the best possible care.</p> <p>The source of the information shared in this way is your electronic GP record that the PCN</p>	<p>The processing of personal data is permitted under the following UK GDPR and DPA conditions:</p> <p>GDPR Article 6(1) (e) - public interest or in the exercise of official authority;</p> <p>DPA Section 8 (d) - processing is necessary for the exercise of statutory functions;</p> <p>The processing of special categories of personal data concerning health is permitted under the following UK GDPR and DPA conditions:</p> <p>GDPR Article 9 (2) (h) - processing is necessary for medical or social care treatment or, the management of health or social care systems and services;</p> <p>DPA Section 10 (1) (c) – processing is necessary for health and social care purposes;</p> <p>In accordance with DPA Schedule 1, Part 1, (2) health or social care purposes means the purposes of preventive or occupational medicine; medical diagnosis; the provision of health care or treatment; the provision of social care, or the management of health</p>	<p>You have the right to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To access, view or request copies of your personal information; • request rectification of any inaccuracy in your personal information; • restrict the processing of your personal information where: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ accuracy of the data is contested, ✓ the processing is unlawful or, ✓ where we no longer need the data for the purposes of the processing. <p>Right to object: In line with the UK GDPR Article 21, you have a general right to raise an objection to the processing of your personal data in some particular circumstances. This right only applies where we cannot demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for continued processing of your personal data for the purposes of direct provision of care, and compliance with a legal obligation to which we are subject.</p>
